- Moved by Councillor Stewart that Council makes a motion to approve Debra Smith's appointment letter from October 20, 2021, and to accept her to be the Village of Heisler's representative on the Parkland Regional Library Board
- Moved by Deputy Mayor Martz that Council makes a motion to accepts the presented CSJ Payment Summary of \$3,150.00 as information.
- Moved by Mayor Wood that Council makes a motion to accept the 2019 MSI Capital allocation in the amount \$61,941 and the 2020 MSI Capital allocation in the amount of \$135,630 as information.






<u>Radon is a radioactive gas</u> that comes from the breakdown of uranium in soil and rock. It is invisible, odorless and tasteless. When radon is released from the ground into the outdoor air, it is diluted and is not a concern. However, in endosed spaces, like homes, it can accumulate to high levels and become a risk to the health of you and your family. Parkland has partnered with the Alberta Lung Association, and with support from Health Canada to make 20 Radon Screening Kits available to library patrons.

To place a hold on a radon screening kit, patrons should follow these simple instructions

- Visit your library's website or come into the library on Wednesday
- Search for PRL Radon Screening Kit.
- Gick Place Request
- Login with your library barcode information
- Select your pick-up location/ home library. Each kit contains a paper survey that should be filled out by the patron and returned to the library.

**The Heisler library** is governed by trustees appointed by the Village of Heisler. Our board chair is Lorie Zimmer and our library manager is Dixie Wolbeck.
