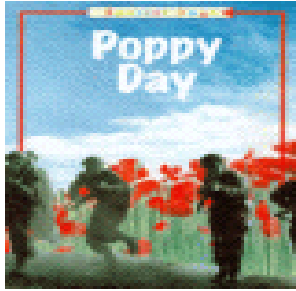

**Radon is a radioactive gas** that comes from the breakdown of uranium in soil and rock. It is invisible, odorless and tasteless. When radon is released from the ground into the outdoor air, it is diluted and is not a concern. However, in enclosed spaces, like homes, it can accumulate to high levels and become a risk to the health of you and your family. Parkland has partnered with the Alberta Lung Association, and with support from Health Canada to make 20 Radon Screening Kits available to library patrons.

To place a hold on a radon screening kit, patrons should follow these simple instructions

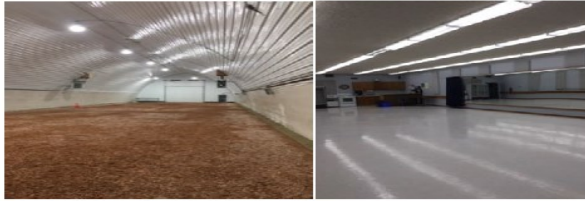
- Visit your library's website or come into the library on Wednesday
- Search for *PRL Radon Screening Kit*.
- Click *Place Request*
- Login with your library barcode information
- Select your pick-up location/ home library. Each kit contains a paper survey that should be filled out by the patron and returned to the library.

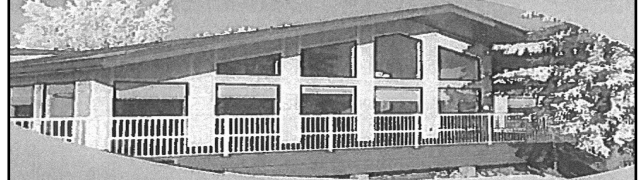
