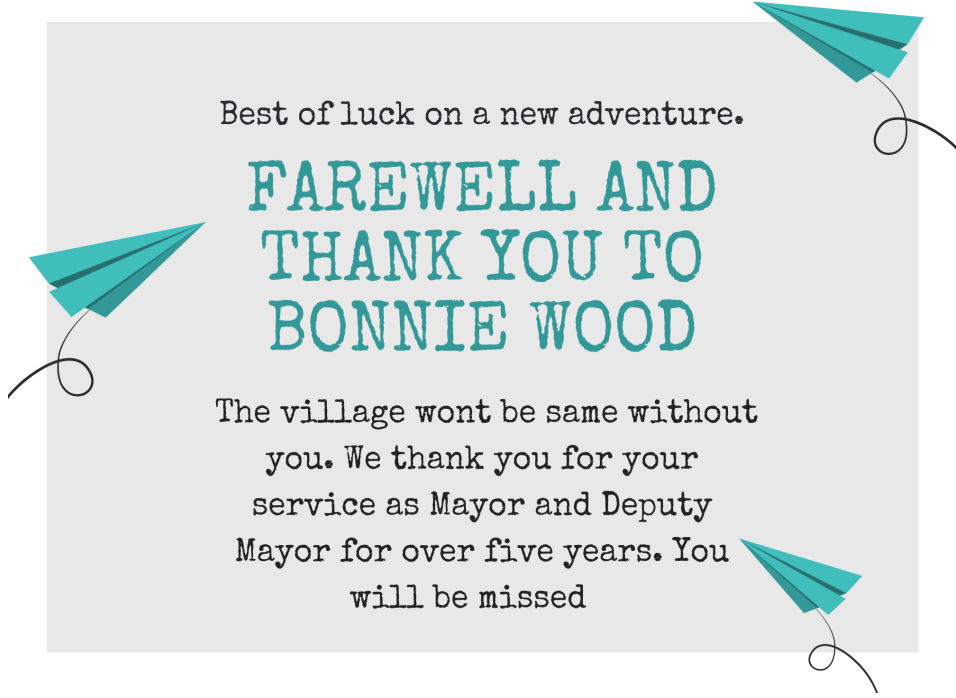

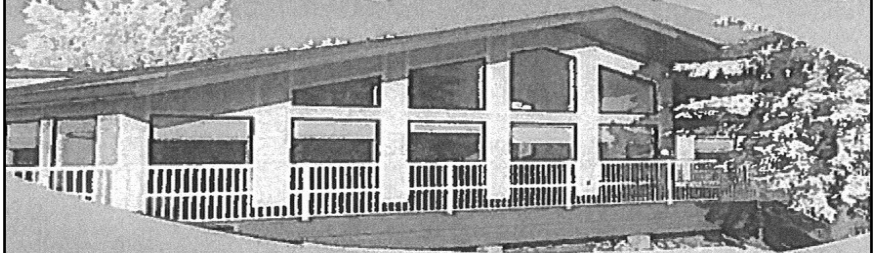

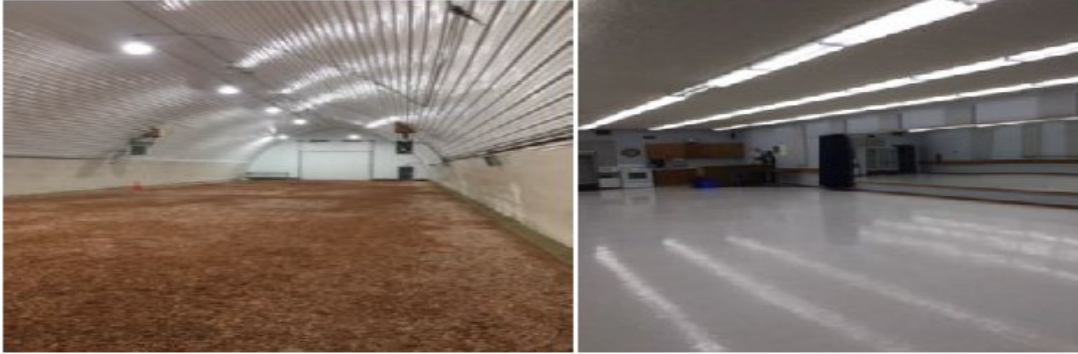


The Village of Heisler needs your help

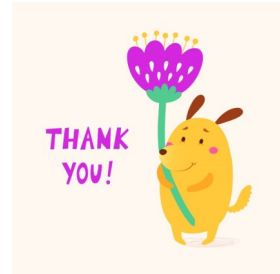

Duties will include but will not be limited to:

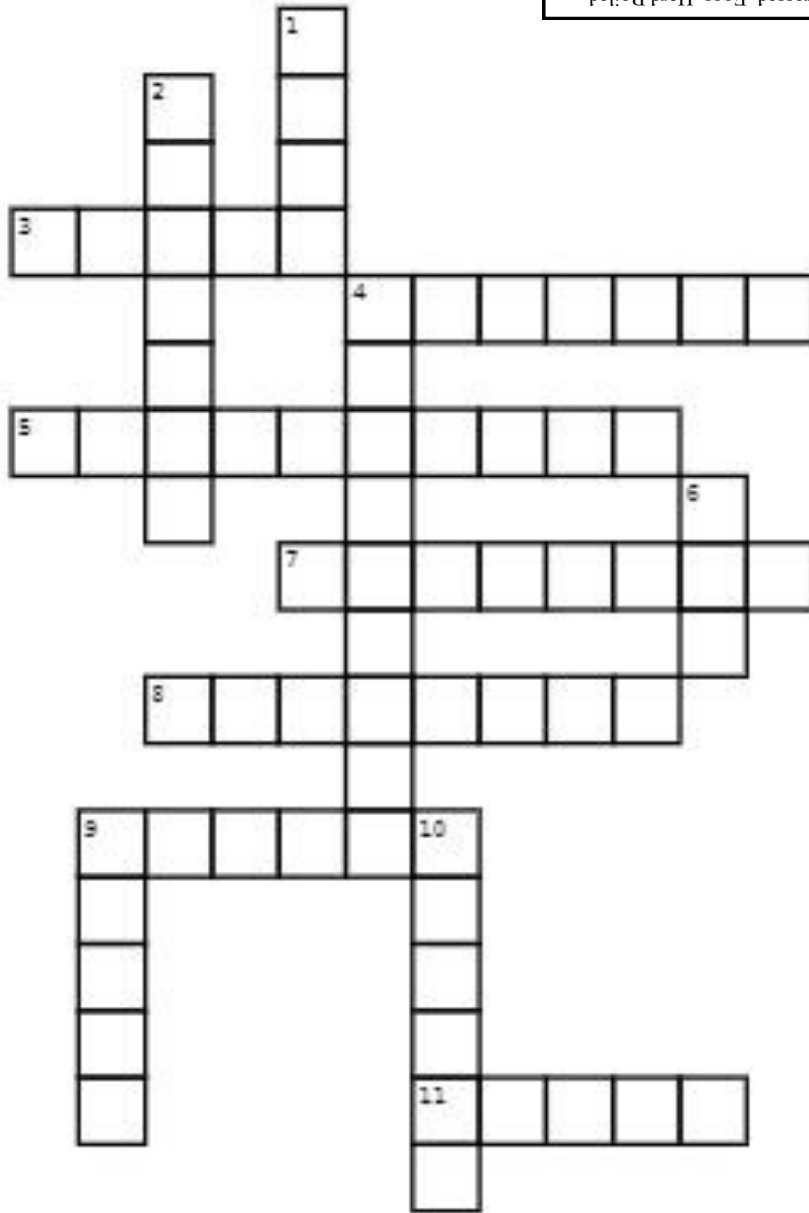
- Assisting the Public Works Foreman with his daily duties

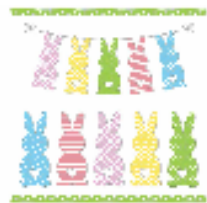
