These are some of the resolutions passed at the July 22, 2021 Regular Council Meeting:

- Moved by Mayor Wood that Council renames Policy GA-005 Community Garden Policy to RO-002 Community Garden Policy.
- Moved by Deputy Mayor Martz that Council advises CAO to put property 4; 16; 42; 34; NW up for tender in the
- amount of outstanding taxes.
- Moved by Deputy Mayor Martz that Council is considering planting trees along highway 855 in spring 2022 and advised CAO to get project started by requesting prices for trees and to contact Flagstaff County regarding the tree program.
- Moved by Mayor Woodthat Council appoints Megara Person as the Substitute Returning Officer for the 2021 Municipal Election.
- Moved by Deputy Mayor Martz that Council appoints Robyn Kroetsch of Heisler, AB to the Village's library board for a three years term, effective June 7, 2021.
- Moved by Deputy Mayor Martz that Council approves Friends of Battle River's request to close Main Street in front of the hotel for approximately one hour in the afternoon of August 8, 2021 for dancing.
- Moved by Mayor Wood that Heisler Council approves Banjo Electric quote # 229818 for the campground electrical upgrade to 200amp in the amount of \$4,461.15 plus GST and advises CAO to start project right away and to apply for a grant for the project.
- Moved by Deputy Mayor Martz that Heisler Council approves Banjo Electric quote # 229820 for the East Lift Station Transfer Switch Upgrade in the amount of \$5,078.18 plus GST and advises CAO to start project right away.
- Moved by Deputy Mayor Martz that Heisler Village Council accepts the payment of 2021 MSI Operating Grant funds in the amount of \$30,296.00 on June 29, 2021 as information.




