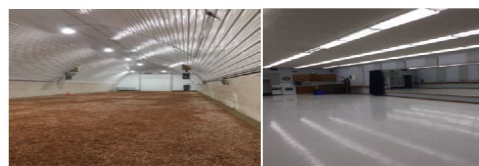

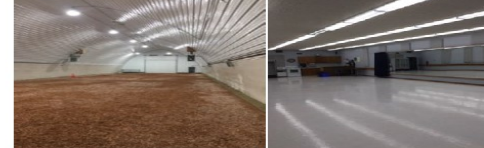

## **The Village of Heisler - a great Community to live!**

With a friendly population of 160, Heisler is a great place to raise children with a large playground, lots of room for riding bikes, two baseball diamonds, and a basketball court for shooting hoops. A walking trail runs through our beautiful DJW Park and Irene Parlby Park Campground, and a walking trail runs through our Pioneers of Flagstaff Park .

- We have a four lane bowling alley, which offers neon bowling. The rec centre lobby and back rooms are available for rent.
- Our library is a member of the Parkland Regional Library System and the Flagstaff literacy program.
- Our naturally soft water is well supplied and is the envy of the County.
- Our safe community is regularly patrolled by the RCMP, and Community Peace Officers.
