Bylaw #564-26 Tax Rate Bylaw 2026

A BYLAW TO AUTHORIZE THE RATES OF TAXATION TO BE LEVIED AGAINST ASSESSABLE PROPERTY WITHIN THE VILLAGE OF HEISLER FOR THE 2025 TAXATION YEAR

WHEREAS, the Village of Heisler has prepared and adopted detailed estimates of municipal revenue, expenses and expenditures at the council meeting held on April 17, 2025 and

WHEREAS, the estimated municipal revenues from all sources other than property taxation total \$ 306,109

WHEREAS, the estimated municipal expenses (including Amortization and excluding other non-cash items) set out in the annual budget for the Village of Heisler for 2025 total \$ 652,455

WHEREAS, the estimated amount required to repay principal debt to be raised by general municipal taxation is \$ -

WHEREAS, the estimated amount required for current year capital expenditures to be raised by general municipal taxation is -\$ 105,000

WHEREAS, the estimated amount required for future financial plans to be raised by municipal taxation is

THEREFORE, the estimated amount to be raised by general municipal taxation is 241,345.67

WHEREAS, the Council is authorized to sub-classify assessed property, and to establish different rates of taxation in respect to each sub-class of property, subject to the Municipal Government Act, Chapter M-26, Revised Statutes of Alberta, 2000; and

WHEREAS, the assessed value of all property in the Village of Heisler as shows on the assessment roll is:

under the authority of the Municipal Government Act, the Council of the Village of Heisler, in the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:
