

**BYLAW 541-22**

**A BYLAW OF THE VILLAGE OF HEISLER, IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA, FOR THE REGULATION AND CONTROL OF VEHICLE WITH FLASHING GREEN LIGHTS**

---

**WHEREAS** the *Traffic Safety Act* authorizes a municipality to regulate and control vehicle traffic as well as parking on streets and property within the municipality;

**AND WHEREAS** the *Municipal Government Act* allows a municipality to pass Bylaws as well as designate authority with respect to streets under its direction, control, and management;

**NOW THEREFORE** the Council of the Village of Heisler in the Province of Alberta enacts a Bylaw to regulate Vehicle Traffic in the Village of Heisler as follows:

**AND THEREFORE**, the Council of the Village of Heisler in the Province of Alberta to enacts the Bylaw 541-22 to provide regulations for "***Use of Flashing Green Lights for Firefighters on Call***". This Bylaw may also be cited as the Village of Heisler Flashing Green Lights.

1. This Bylaw may be cited as Village of Heisler **Bylaw 541-22 Flashing Green Lights** as follows:

2. Use of Flashing Green Lights to read:

- (a) Full-time or volunteer firefighters may carry, on or in a vehicle, other than an emergency vehicle, a lamp that produces intermittent flashes of green light and may operate the lamp if the vehicle is proceeding to a fire or other emergency.
- (b) No person other than a full-time or volunteer firefighter shall operate a lamp that produces intermittent flashes of green light.
- (c) Nothing in this section shall be construed as to permit a full-time or volunteer firefighter to operate a vehicle in contravention of the *Traffic Safety Act*, Provincial regulations, or this Bylaw.

3. If any portion of this Bylaw is declared invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the invalid portion shall be severed, and the remainder of the Bylaw is deemed valid.


4. This Bylaw becomes effective on the date it is signed and passed.
