

These are some of the resolutions passed at the November 25, 2021

Regular Council Meeting:

- Moved by Mayor Wood that Village of Heisler Council reviews and reaffirms their acceptance of the terms contained in Bylaw 505-18 Council Code of Conduct Bylaw.
- Moved by Deputy Mayor Martz that Heisler Council gave all reading to 538-21 Fire Bylaw.
- Moved by Mayor Wood that Council discusses the item and decides that Council wants to go forward with the idea of establishing a Village of Heisler Social Committee in the coming year and to advice CAO to place a post in the village newsletter.
- Moved by Mayor Wood that Heisler Council discusses the 2021 Fire Fighter Appreciation Steak Supper and that due to the Covid-19 situation Council decides that all active Heisler Fire Fighter receive this year a \$100.00 gift card from Big Willy's Bar or The Heisler General Store or Heisler Hair and Massage instead of having the annually Fire Fighter Appreciation Steak Supper.
- Moved by Deputy Mayor Martz that Council approves the 2021 Operating Budget as the 2022 Interim Operating Budget pending further budget deliberations in 2022.
- Moved by Mayor Wood that Heisler Village Council approves the proposed Flagstaff Family & Community Services 2022 budget with Heisler's requisition of \$1,392.
- Moved by Deputy Mayor Martz that Heisler Village Council makes a motion to accept the MSI-CAP 14222 Lawn Mower Replacement grant approval in the amount of \$29,500 and that PW ordered the new Kubota as information.
- Moved by Mayor Wood That Heisler Council makes a motion to pay the unbudgeted expense for the purchase of a new Foam Pump for the Fire Truck in the amount of \$1,198.47 incl. gst from reserves.


