## JANUARY 2018 NEWSLETTER

### These are some of the resolutions passed at the December 15, 2017 regular council meeting:

- To renew the bylaw enforcement services contract with Daryl Reinke of NIC.212 Services for 2018
- To partner with Flagstaff County and the Villages of Alliance and Loughheed and jointly submit an application to the Alberta Community Partnership grant program for assistance with creating provincially required Intermunicipal Collaboration Frameworks, Intermunicipal Development Plans and Municipal Development Plans documents
- To approve a recommendation from the Regional Emergency Services Committee to apply to the Alberta Community Partnership grant program for a \$20,000 implementation budget for the new Regional Emergency Services Society, and that if the grant is not approved, that each municipality fund **\$2,200** of the cost
- To approve the November 6/17 lodging expense of Public Works Foreman, Jordan McIntyre of **\$135.16**
- To approve CAO training expenses of 19 hours for course work completed on her own time between September 11-December 8/17 & approve CAO travel expenses from September 12-November 30/17 of **\$370.50**
- To approve Fire Chief, Joe Martz's meeting and travel expenses from January 10-November 8/17 of **\$948.00**
- To approve Mayor, Bonita Wood's meeting and travel expenses from October 20-December 15/17 of **967.00**
- To approve Deputy Mayor, Brandon Martz's meeting and travel expenses from October 20-December 15/17 of **\$535.00**
- To approve Councillor Jon Williams' meeting and travel expenses from October 20-December 15/17 of **\$858.00**
- To adopt an Interim Operating Budget for 2018
- To approve the 2018 Flagstaff Regional Solid Waste Management Association Budget as amended with a requisition of **\$24,401.49**
- To hire Nicholas Howell for the janitorial position

Please remember that every occupant or owner of any property, other than a residential property shall within twenty-four (24) hours (**excluding Sundays and holidays**) after the cessation of a snowfall, remove all snow and ice from any sidewalk adjacent to said property.

Every occupant or owner of any **residential** property shall within seventy-two (72) hours (**excluding Sundays and holidays**) after the cessation of a snowfall, remove all snow and ice from any sidewalk adjacent to the said property. ~pursuant to the Snow Removal Bylaw.

Dog owners are reminded that annual dog tags are required for all dogs in the Village of Heisler for a fee. Tags allow village staff to find the owner quickly and efficiently.

If your pet is found without an identification tag, the animal will be sent to the Forestburg Vet Clinic and the owner will be subject to a fine—Dog Control Bylaw #468-12

### Tags are DUE BY: JANUARY 31, 2018

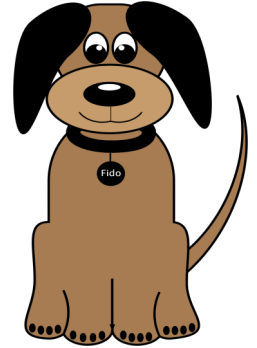
Regular dog license: \$15.00

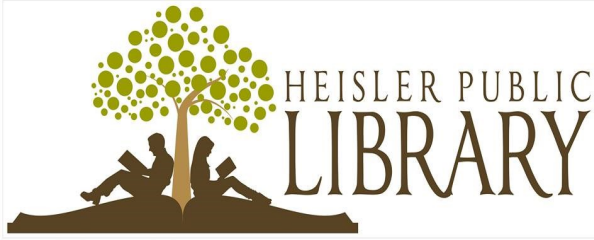
