

Friendly Reminder: DOG TAGS

Dog owners are reminded that annual dog tags are required for all dogs in the Village of Heisler for a fee. Tags allow village staff to find the owner quickly and efficiently.

If your pet is found without an identification tag, the animal will be sent to the Forestburg Vet Clinic and the owner will be subject to a fine—Dog Control Bylaw #468-12

Tags are DUE BY: JANUARY 31, 2018Regular dog license: \$15.00After Jan 31/18: \$30.00

Vicious dog license: \$100.00 After Jan 31/18: \$200.00

Replacement tags: \$5.00

Property Taxes were due on December 31, 2017. If your account had an outstanding balance after DECEMBER 31st, it was penalized 16% as per the Penalties on Unpaid Taxes bylaw #451-11



Attention Heisler Property Owners/Occupants:



Snow removal season is upon us. Please remember that every occupant or owner of any property, other than a residential property shall within twenty-four **(24)** hours **(excluding Sundays and holidays)** after the cessation of a snowfall, remove all snow and ice from any sidewalk adjacent to said property.

Every occupant or owner of any **residential** property shall within seventy-two **(72)** hours **(excluding Sundays and holidays)** after the cessation of a snowfall, remove all snow and ice from any sidewalk adjacent to the said property. ~pursuant to the Snow Removal Bylaw.

We hope your Christmas was all you hoped it would be and HAPPY NEW YEAR from the Heisler Municipal Library.






