e) New Park Project

### **Motion 34/11**

Moved by Deputy Mayor Steil to restore this property into a park setting as a capital project under the MSI Capital Grant, and to get 2 quotes, one from Sunderman Trucking and one from Wayne Zimmer to landscape and move the soil back into a kidney shape.


