- To approve the meeting and travel expenses for Fire Chief Joe Martz for 2018 in the amount of \$1,251.00.
- To approve the Firemen operating expenses for 2018 in the amount of \$420.00.
- To approve Councillor Williams' meeting & travel expenses for Aug 6 – Dec 14, 2018 at the amount of \$1,263.00.
- To approve meeting & travel expenses for Mayor Bonita Wood for Oct 4 - Dec 14, 2018 at the amount of \$854.00.
- To approve meeting & travel expenses for Deputy Mayor Martz for Aug 27 - Dec 14, 2018 at the amount of \$662.00.
- To approve meeting & travel expenses for DEM Jordan McIntyre for November 2018 at the amount of \$174.51.
- To approve meeting & travel expenses for former DEM Shailen Weselak for Feb 22 – Sep 13, 2018 at the amount of \$636.00.
- To approve Interim CAO online U of A Training 'Local Government Finance' starting January 7, 2019 at the amount of \$795.00.

Every occupant or owner of any residential property shall within seventy-two (72) hours (excluding Sundays and holidays) after a snowfall, remove all snow and ice from any sidewalk adjacent to the said property pursuant to the Snow Removal Bylaw.

If you are going to be away, please ensure someone shovels your sidewalk and please do not string electrical cords (for block heaters, etc.) across sidewalks.

The Heisler library is a proud member of Parkland Regional Library system, a cooperative of 50 public libraries across central Alberta. With your library membership, you are a member of 50 other unique libraries and have access to their services. You can also join other Alberta library systems. **Alberta Wide Borrowing (ME Libraries)**

Library members can register with non-Parkland public libraries across the province to easily borrow physical items (not eContent) using their Parkland Regional Library card. Borrowed materials can be returned to any public library, too. All this for free!

If you want to become a Heisler library member come in and sign up for FREE. We'll even give you a free book bag hand crafted by a dedicated board member (Bernice Dale).

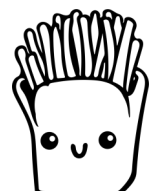
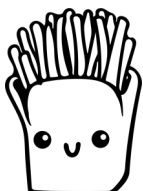
