



These are some of the resolutions passed at the June 24, 2021 Regular Council Meeting:

- Moved by Deputy Mayor Martz that Heisler Council by unanimous consent gives third and final reading to Bylaw # 536-21 the Fees and Charges Bylaw.
- Moved by Mayor Wood that Council reviews, approves and adopts Policy GA-005 Community Garden Policy.
- Moved by Mayor Wood that Council reviews, approves and adopts Policy RO-001 Campground Reservation Policy.
- Moved by Deputy Mayor Martz hat Council accepts a Municipal Affairs letter from June 8, 2021 stating that the Village of Heisler is undergoing an Assessment Audit in 2021 as information.
- Moved by Mayor Wood that Heisler Village Council approves a motion extending the Fire Services Agreement and Regional Fire Chief Agreement to December 31, 2021.
- Moved by Mayor Wood that Council discusses the request and makes a motion to allow Sven Bernhard to close Main Street partially for a show and shine and some other activities during the Heisler Dance Weekend on July 24, 2021.
- Moved by Deputy Mayor Martz that Heisler Council advises CAO to add pump for east lift station to MSI Grant application as advised in motion 21-05-117.
- Moved by Deputy Mayor Martz that Council discusses dust control and to approve Flagstaff County estimate for dust suppressant with MG30 just for 530 meters on Manning Ave up to Main Street in the amount of \$4,012 excluding Gst.
- Moved by Deputy Mayor Martz that Heisler Council instructs the CAO to pay Mayor Bonnie Wood meeting & travel expenses for January 21, 2021 to June 24, 2021 in the amount of \$1,080.50.
- Moved by Mayor Wood that Heisler Council instructs the CAO to pay Deputy Mayor Brandon Martz meeting & travel expenses for Jan 21-June 24, 2021 in the amount of \$761.00.
- Council welcomed delegation from residents to present their concerns and complaint regarding flooding on property 420 Rutherford.

The Heisler library is governed by trustees appointed by the Village of Heisler. Our board chair is Lorie Zimmer and our library manager is Dixie Wolbeck. Library board meetings are open to the public. Board members are: Lorie Zimmer, Janice Badry, Val Volk, Bernice Dale, Kelly Williams, Danielle Wolbeck and Bonnie Wood (Village liaison).
