- Moved by Deputy Mayor Martz that Village of Heisler makes a motion to consider the village property 427
 Haultain Ave as a potential community garden property and to advice CAO to get in contact with requesting resident for more information about ideas regarding the project and to advice CAO to prepare a Community Garden Policy.
- Moved by Deputy Mayor Martz that Council reviews and approves the proposed resolution for the Flagstaff Regional Emergency Services Society formation:
- Moved by Councillor Williams that Council makes a motion to accept Select Engineering's recommendation outlined in the letter from April 20, 2021 and to approve Bi-Systems Electric & Controls Ltd. quote in the amount of \$76,200 excluding G.S.T. and to approve Bi-Systems Electric & Controls Ltd. as the general contractor for the Village of Heisler 2021 Water Treatment Plant Mechanical Upgrade Project.
- Moved by Councillor Williams that Council makes a motion to accept that the Village of Heisler was invoiced with \$2,641 for Police Funding Model (PFM) Fiscal 2021 and that CAO made a payment at the last accounts payable period, as information.


