**Regular Council Meeting**

- Moved by Mayor Martz that Council makes a motion to accept Lorie Zimmer's resignation from the Heisler Library Board as information.
- Moved by Councillor Rohe that Council makes a motion to accept the 2023 Annual Assessment Audit result, stating the Calculated Residential Assessment Level at 0.995 and the Calculated Non-Residential Assessment Level at 1.000 which is in the standard for Median Assessment Ratio as information.
- Moved by Mayor Martz that Council reviewed and approved attached Flagstaff County 2023 Dust Suppressant Estimate Option#1 - 1728 meters on Strome Street, Manning Ave and the gravel section on Main Street in the amount of \$9,005.00 excluding Gst.
- Moved by Mayor Martz that Heisler Council makes a motion to approve Forestburg Transit Mix Ltd. Quote for 2023 Drainage Improvements Manning Ave, Between Main Street and Sifton Street in the amount of \$40,435 as stated in Select Engineering Consultants Ltd. Letter from May 10, 2023.

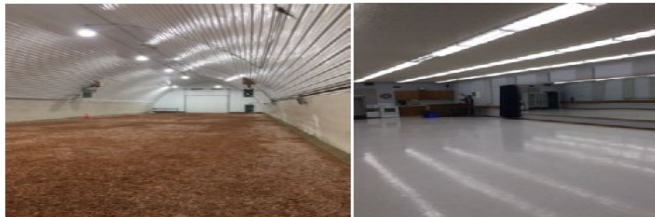

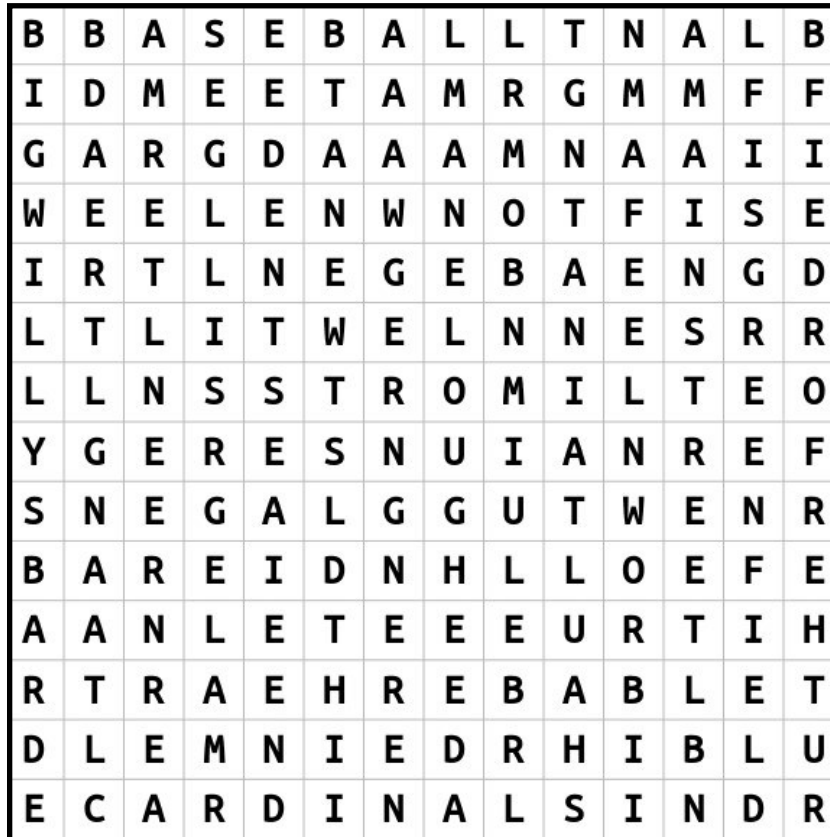
