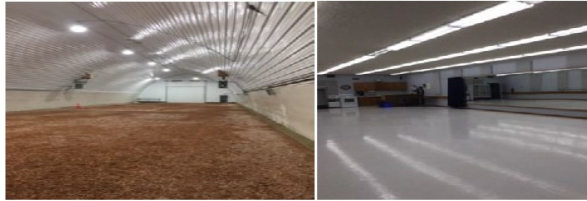

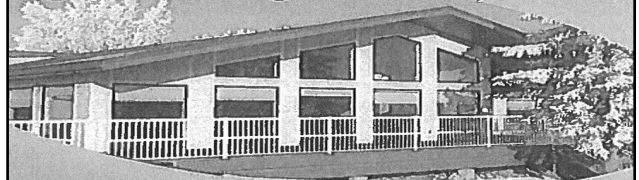

- To approve the appointment of Murray Hampshire as Chair of both the LARB and CARB for a two-year term, expiring March 2023.

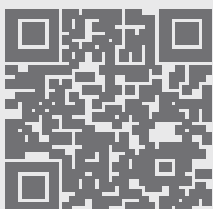

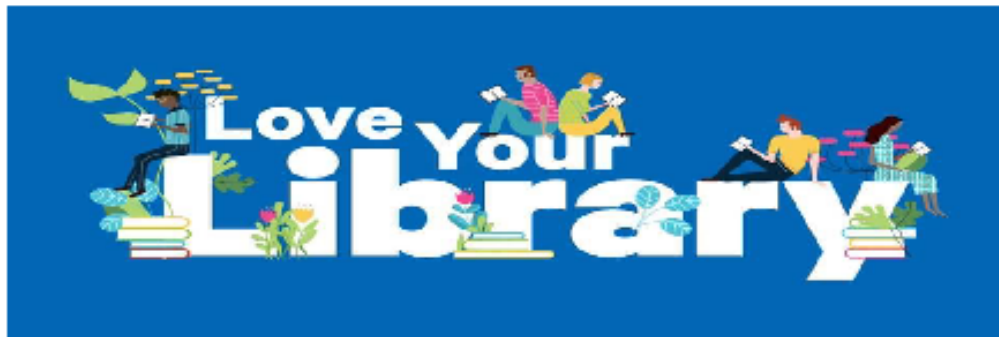
