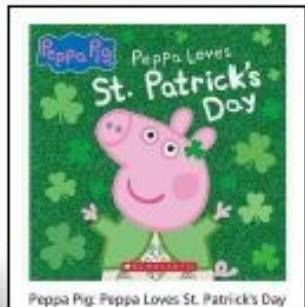


Mission
