Mission of the Heisler Library Board: The primary aim of the Heisler Library Board is to be able to keep our library open to the residents of Heisler and surrounding area. We will keep lines of communication open between board members, library users and the librarians so we will be able to offer our library users exactly what they are looking for. We will strive to keep up with materials and programs to help our members with self-development, information gathering and enjoyment.

HERE ARE SOME OF THE THINGS YOU CAN DO AT THE LIBRARY

Wireless Internet

The library is superpowered by Axia Supernet. The speed is literally awesome. Use it on our public access computers or your own device and avoid a "high-speed" headache.

Alberta Wide Borrowing (ME Libraries)

Library members can <u>register</u> with non-Parkland public libraries across the province to easily borrow physical items (not eContent) using their Parkland Regional Library card. Borrowed materials can be returned to any public library, too. All this for free!

Interlibrary Loans

Borrow print and audio books, movies, music CDs, game discs and even journal and newspaper articles from libraries across the province. Request using your Parkland Regional Library card number and PIN or ask library staff to find / request items for you. We will look far and wide - beyond Alberta and even internationally - to track down specific items and contact you when your item arrives so you can pick it up.

The Heisler Public Library is governed by trustees appointed by the Village of Heisler. Our board chair is Lorie Zimmer and our library manager is Dixie Wolbeck. Library board meetings are open to the public. Board members are: Lorie Zimmer, Val Volk, Janice Badry, Bernice Dale, Moyra Heisler, Nadine Massong, Kelly Williams, Danielle Wolbeck and Bonnie Wood (Village liaison).

If you have a book title you would like us to order please come into the library. These books will be purchased from our allotment funds and will remain on our shelves. 
