

These are some of the HIGHLIGHTS from the April 17, 2025 Regular Council Meeting

Motion 25-04-048 Moved by Councillor Rohe that Heisler Council approves the 2024 Audit Financial Statements as presented.

Motion 25-04-057 Moved by Mayor Martz that that Heisler Council reviews and discusses the proposed 2025 Final Operating Budget and to adopt the budget in the amount of \$627,919 including amortization in the amount of \$106,090.

Motion 25-04-061 Moved by Mayor Martz that Heisler Council gives third and final reading to the Bylaw #559-25 - Tax Rate Bylaw 2025 and to adopt it as presented.

Motion 25-04-064 Moved by Councillor Rohe that Council makes a motion to accept as information that there are 2 parcels of land in the municipality that are more than one year in arrears and that the Tax Recovery Arrears List for 2025 has been prepared, mailed out to the Land Titles Office and emailed to Alberta Treasures and Finances Board on March 31, 2025.

Nomination Period: January 1, 2025 – September 22, 2025 Nomination Day Deadline: September 22, 2025, at 12:00 p.m. Election Day: October 20, 2025, polls will open at 10:00 a.m. and close at 8:00 p.m.

Our Council consists of a Mayor, a Deputy Mayor, and a Councillor who are the elected officials. Members of Council are elected to a four-year term.

As a member of Council, you will have the opportunity to significantly influence the future of your community. All decisions are made by Council as a whole, at Council, or via Committee and/or Board meetings. As an individual member of Council, you will not have the power to commit the Village of Heisler to any expenditure or to direct the activities of employees of the municipality; all direction of this I nature is done via the Council motions at regular or special meetings.

As a member of the Village of Heisler Council you must be able to commit to the four-year term in office running until October 2025 and during that time you are required to attend:

- Regular meetings of council which take place about mid month
- Meetings of other boards and agencies you have been appointed to as a council representative
- Conferences, conventions, seminars and workshops for training and discussions
- Social events promoting your municipality

You will also need to spend time reading material, e.g. monthly Council Meeting Agenda, provided by the Chief Administrative Officer (CAO), etc. This is necessary in order to be prepared for meetings and making informed decisions.


To be eligible to run as a candidate, you must be:

- Eligible to vote in 2025 municipal elections
- At least 18 years old
- A Canadian citizen
- A resident of the Village of Heisler on Election Day (October 20, 2025)
- A resident of the Village of Heisler for the 6 consecutive months before Nomination Day (March 22 - September 22, 2025)
- · Must not be otherwise ineligible or disqualified


