These are some of the resolutions passed at the Sep 15, 2020 Regular Council Meeting:

- To approve Bylaw #529-20, Amendment Flagstaff Regional SDAB Bylaw.
- To advice CAO to send out a feedback letter to MLA regarding the proposed Assessment Model Changes.
- To appoint Larry James as the designated property Assessor for the Village of Heisler.
- To approve the new Flagstaff Regional Subdivision & Development Appeal Board Agreement including the Village of Amisk.
- To approve to take reservations for the campground in the future and that CAO will prepare and present an appropriate policy for approval at a later council meeting.
- To advice CAO/PW to remove sidewalk at 202 Rutherford Ave and to fill the holes.
- To accept the Director of Emergency Management resignation.
- To accept the Bylaw Enforcement Officer resignation.
- To approve Deputy Mayor meeting & travel expenses in the amount of \$760.00.
- To make a motion to advice CAO to apply for the MSP grant for the Water Treatment Plant mechanical upgrade in the amount of \$50,000 and to apply with the GTF grant for remaining costs.
- To approve Mayor meeting & travel expenses in the amount of \$720.00.
- To renew the CAO Employment Agreement with Heidi Rohe.


