If this turns out well we will look at opening it once per season, except winter.

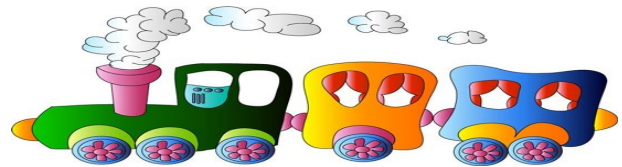

How Remembrance Day in Canada is observed in 2018

In 2018, Remembrance Day falls on a Sunday, which will lead to some confusion on how the holiday is treated across Canada. The Federal Statutory holiday is observed on Monday, November 12 and all Federal Government offices will be closed.



Why Remembrance Day is important

November 11 marks the signing of the armistice (peace agreement) between the Allies and Germany at Compiègne, France. The armistice took effect at eleven o'clock in the morning - the "eleventh hour of the eleventh day of the eleventh month." However, while this date is used to reflect the end of the whole war, it technically relates to the cease fire on the Western Front; fighting continued after 11 November in parts of the Ottoman Empire. After the 'end' of the war in 1918, it didn't take long before the signing of the armistice was adopted as a suitable time and date for countries involved in the war to mark the sacrifice of their soldiers, with official remembrance services taking place in the UK and USA in 1919.
