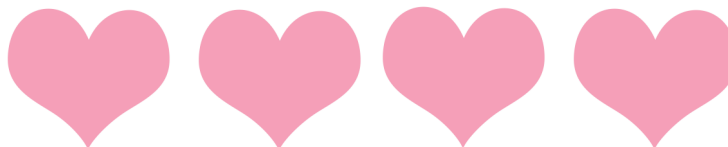
With last years donations being a success we will be doing taking donations again this year!

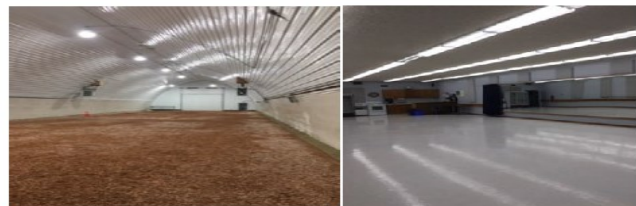
