

 - Moved by Deputy Mayor Wood that Heisler Council makes a motion to advise CAO to pay the unbudgeted expense for the 2022 annual Fire Department Appreciation BBQ.
- Moved by Deputy Mayor Wood that Heisler Council makes a motion to accepts the CCBF grant approval for Basketball Court Paving in the amount of \$25,000 and the CCBF grant approval for

Sidewalk Repair/Renewal and Walking Paths Paving in the amount of \$137,000 as information.

- Moved by Councilor Stewart that Heisler Village Council approves the proposed Flagstaff Family & Community Services 2023 budget with Heisler's requisition of \$1,248.75.












Muffin Wednesdays

The Heisler library is a proud member of the Parkland Regional Library system, a cooperative of 49 public libraries across central Alberta. With your free Heisler library membership you can access all member libraries or return items at them. You can access computers in any Alberta library without a membership. There are two laptops and one desktop available at the Heisler library. Photocopying is a service we offer. Get in touch with library staff at www.heislerlibrary@prl.ab.ca or visit our website at www.heislerlibrary.ab.ca. Phone 780-889-3925. We are open every Wednesday from 9 – 5 (closed 12-1). Wi-Fi service is available 24/7. Dixie or Liza are available to help with your requests.

Muffin Wednesday will happen the 1st Wednesday of each month. Come on in and enjoy a muffin, a visit and maybe even check out a book.

Power Monitors are also available through Parkland libraries. Your Heisler library has this item available year-round if you would like to know how much power some of your household appliances consume.


