**These are some of the resolutions passed at the October, 2022**

**Regular Council Meeting:**

- Moved by Deputy Mayor Wood that Council accepts the information of the 2021 Municipal Indicator Results, indicating that Heisler is not at risk and will not appear in this year's Municipal Indicator Results report as presented.
- Moved by Deputy Mayor Wood that Heisler Council makes a motion to advise CAO to pay the unbudgeted expense for the 2022 annual Fire Department Appreciation BBQ.
- Moved by Deputy Mayor Wood that Heisler Council makes a motion to accept the CCBF grant approval for Basketball Court Paving in the amount of \$25,000 and the CCBF grant approval for Sidewalk Repair/Renewal and Walking Paths Paving in the amount of \$137,000 as information.
- Moved by Councilor Stewart that Village of Heisler Council discusses and approves the proposed Flagstaff Regional Emergency Services Society (FRESS) 2023 Budget with a total municipal requisition of \$1,020,000.00 (increase of 2%) distributed to member municipalities utilizing the latest StatsCan Census Data (2021) and an annual requisition for the Village of Heisler in the amount of \$10,368.37.
- Moved by Councilor Stewart that Heisler Village Council approves the proposed Flagstaff Family & Community Services 2023 budget with Heisler's requisition of \$1,248.75.

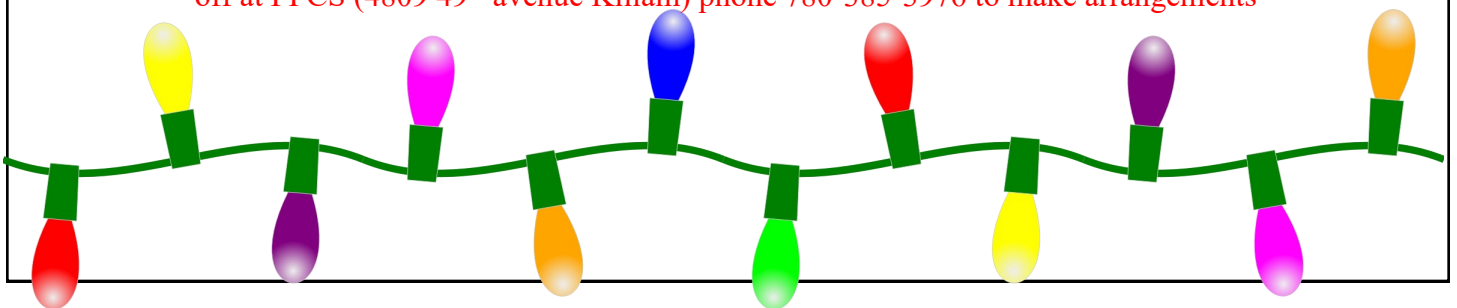

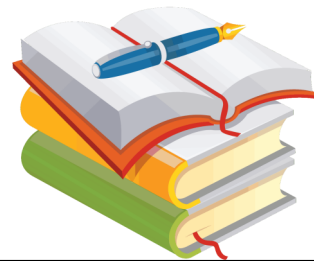
