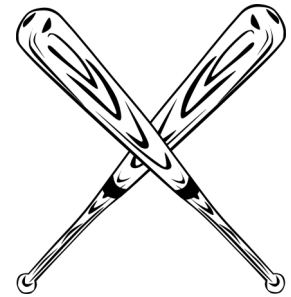

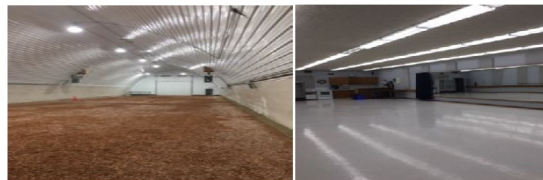

Dear Mayor Martz and Council,

Thank you for participating in and cooperating with the preliminary review conducted by Municipal Affairs in response to a petition requesting an inspection into the Village of Heisler. The intent of the preliminary review was to identify the concerns and issues that led to the petition, and assist me in determining whether an inspection, as legislated in the *Municipal Government Act (MGA)*, is the appropriate way to address the situation.

The review included ministry records of correspondence and contacts related to the Village of Heisler, an internet search that included a review of the website for the Village of Heisler, review of the audited financial statements for the village in the last four years, and interviews with the petition representative, village council members, and administration.

The review identified some areas of potential improvement, such as the transparency of council in making decisions and effectiveness of council in communicating with the public. The review also identified instances where some council decisions were not supported by some residents; however, the review did not identify any evidence that these decisions were contrary to the *MGA*, or were irregular, improper, or improvident.

A concern was also identified with respect to maintenance of a drainage ditch and stormwater mitigation. I acknowledge the village has taken some steps to resolve this matter, and the affected landowner has not been satisfied with these steps. I also note Municipal Affairs has no role in adjudicating disputes of this nature. I encourage the village to ensure it is meeting all its obligations under Section 532 of the *MGA*.

I do not believe the findings of the preliminary review warrant an inspection of the municipality; an inspection is an extraordinary measure with significant cost and implications.

While I am not ordering an inspection, I believe there are supports offered by Municipal Affairs that may benefit the village in addressing some of the concerns identified in the preliminary review.
