Interlibrary Loans

Borrow print and audio books, movies, music CDs, game discs and even journal and newspaper articles from libraries across the province. [Request online](#) using your Parkland Regional Library card number and PIN or ask library staff to find / request items for you. We will look far and wide – beyond Alberta and even internationally – to track down specific items and contact you when your item arrives so you can pick it up.

Photocopying / Printing

The library can satisfy your need for black and white copying/printing for \$0.25 per page. Colour copies may also be available at an additional charge. Just ask us!

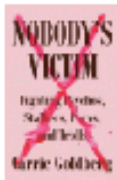
Borrowed materials can be returned to any public library. All this FREE!
