

  - Moved by Brandon Martz that Council makes a motion to not increase the 2023 ATCO Franchise Fee.
    - Moved by Mayor Wood that Council conducts CAO Evaluation and approves and signs new CAO
       Employment Agreement.
  - Moved by Mayor Wood that council approves the 3-year MuniSight MuniWare Software Momentum renewal in the amount of \$3,588.48 per year as presented.





**The Heisler library** is a proud member of the Parkland Regional Library system, a cooperative of 49 public libraries across central Alberta. With your free Heisler library membership you can access all member libraries or return items at them. You can access computers in any Alberta library without a membership. There are two laptops and one desktop available at the Heisler library. Photocopying is a service we offer. Get in touch with library staff at www.heislerlibrary@prl.ab.ca or our website at www.heislerlibrary.ab.ca. Phone 780-889-3925. We are open every Wednesday from 9 – 5 (closed 12-1). Dixie or Liza are available to help with your requests.

**The library purchases** new books regularly and has a large print rotating collection. Since January the library has purchased and added to our shelves 69 books. This includes early reading books, nonfiction and adult fiction books. Audio books are also rotated on the shelves and supplied by Parkland. There are many hard-covered children's books to check out. All items have a 3 week check out period but can be renewed 5 times (on line or in person). We do not have overdue fines but expect items be returned in good condition.
